Every September, Premier Cares Foundation holds a community event to raise funds and awareness for prostate cancer.

On Saturday, September 25, over 200 people gathered at Eastdale Village, the home of Premier Medical Group's Urology offices. Participants walked a 1-mile loop in honor of loved ones and those who are battling the disease. This event raised over \$50,000 for those who need support during their cancer challenges.

Local singer, Maria Hickey kicked off the Walk with an inspiring rendition of the National Anthem and the day was emceed by Annie from Q92. Participants were treated to live music from The Band Hudson, a dance performance from Queen City Dance, and even on site massages from Samantha Fulton of FulBeing Physical Therapy.

THE CARE FUND AT WORK . . .

Premier Cares Foundation established the Care Fund as a way to reach patients throughout the entire Hudson Valley region. Funds raised by the Foundation are distributed through partnerships with the Community Action Partnership for Dutchess County, Family of Woodstock and Jewish Family Services of Orange County.

These agencies are poised to respond immediately to the needs of their communities. Premier Cares Foundation provides the resources these agencies need to respond efficiently when a situation arises that meets our scope of criteria. Basic criteria includes financially-challenged urologic and gastrointestinal patients in the Hudson Valley who desperately need help while they fight their illness.

Since 2013, nearly \$100,00 has been provided to local patients to pay for medication not covered by insurance, housing, transportation, utilities and other expenses.
